

Allan Brewer-Carías - Emeritus Professor at the Central University of Venezuela

Allan R. Brewer-Carías is a distinguished Venezuelan lawyer, academic, and author, renowned for his extensive contributions to the fields of public law, constitutional law, rule of law and public administration. He earned his Lawyer degree and Juris Doctor from the Central University of Venezuela in 1962 and 1964, respectively, both with summa cum laude honors. Brewer-Carías began his teaching career at the same university in 1963, holding esteemed positions including Head of the Administrative Law Chair and Director of the Public Law Institute. Internationally, he has been a visiting scholar at various prestigious institutions and Professor at Cambridge University UK., Université de Paris II, and Columbia Law School. He is a member of numerous academies and was Vice President of the International Academy of Comparative Law. He has authored over 250 books and 1,200 articles and was awarded the National Science Prize of Venezuela in 1981. In public service, Brewer-Carías held several positions including Legal Deputy Counselor at the Ministry of Justice, Head of the Presidential Commission on Public Administration and Minister of State for Decentralization.
