

Marco D'Alberti - Justice of the Constitutional Court of Italy

Marco D'Alberti is an Italian jurist, Justice of the Constitutional Court of Italy since 2022. Marco D'Alberti is Professor Emeritus of Administrative Law at the University of Rome 'Sapienza', since 2019. Before that, he taught at the Universities of Camerino, Urbino and Ancona, at the Higher School of Public Administration, and at 'Sapienza' itself.

He has researched and taught several times in foreign universities. He has been, among others: Visiting Scholar at the Universities of Cambridge (1980-81), Harvard (1982) and Yale (1987, 1988); Professeur invité at the University of Paris II - Panthéon-Assas (1990 and 2005) and Visiting Professor at the School of Law of Columbia University in New York (1995, 2016, 2018).

He is a member of the Académie internationale de droit comparé (since 1998), the Board of Directors of the European Public Law Organization (since 2007), and the Council of the International Society of Public Law (since 2013).
