

Luis María Díez-Picazo – Judge at the Supreme Court of Spain

Luis María Díez-Picazo serves as a Judge at the Supreme Court of Spain and is part-time Professor of Constitutional Law at Cunef-Universidad (Madrid). Before his appointment to the judiciary in 2008, he had been full Professor of Constitutional Law in two different Spanish universities (Málaga and Castilla-La Mancha) and at the Judicial School of Barcelona. Between 1989 and 1997 he held a chair as full-time Professor of Comparative Public Law at the European University Institute (Florence) and for two years was Head of its Law Department. He has been visiting Professor in several universities, including Indiana, Paris II, Bordeaux and Pau. He has also taken part in various groups of experts, both at national and European level. He is the Dean of the EPLO European Law and Governance School (ELGS) of Athens.
