

David Feldman – Emeritus Professor at the University of Cambridge

David Fieldman is an Emeritus Professor at the University of Cambridge. From 2000 to 2004 he held the position of Legal Adviser to the Parliamentary Joint Select Committee on Human Rights and Professor of Law at the University of Birmingham. He was appointed Rouse Ball Professor of English Law and Fellow of Downing College at the University of Cambridge and later he was Chairman of the Faculty Board of Law. He was a judge at the Constitutional Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina and served as its Vice President from 2006 to 2009. He took on a number of senior honorary visiting fellowships, including the Miegunyah Distinguished Visiting Fellowship at the University of Melbourne and the Sir John C. Smith Senior Visiting Scholarship at the University of Nottingham. He has been appointed Q.C. honoris causa (now K.C.) and awarded the degree of Doctor of Laws honoris causa by the University of Bristol. He has also been elected a Fellow of the British Academy (F.B.A.) and an Honorary Fellow of Exeter College, Oxford.
