

Spyridon Flogaitis – Director of the European Public Law Organization (EPLO), Professor of Public Law at the National University of Athens

Professor Spyridon Flogaitis is the Director of the European Public Law Organization (EPLO) and President of its Board of Directors. He is Professor of Administrative Law at the Law School of the University of Athens, Attorney at Law at the High Court and the Council of State of Greece, former President of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal and former Alternate Minister for Foreign Affairs (2015) and Former Minister of Interior, Greece (in 2007 and 2009). He is also an Honorary Fellow at Wolfson College of the University of Cambridge and Doctor Honoris Causa at the NSPSPA in Bucharest, Romania, the Faculty of Law of the University of Lisbon in Portugal, at the Titu Maiorescu University in Bucharest, Romania, the State University of Mariupol in Ukraine, and the USPEE in Chisinau, Moldova.

He is Vice-President at the Appeals Board of the European Space Agency, Member of the Appeals Board of EUMETSAT, Member of the Appeals Board of the European Centre for Medium-Range Weather Forecasts and member of the International Civil Service Commission of the United Nations. He is former member and President of the Administrative Tribunal of EBRD and former Chair of the Joint Appeals Board at IFAD in the UN. He is former Vice-President of the Organization of Intellectual Property, Greece, former Arthur Goodhart Professor at the Faculty of Law, Cambridge University, former Yorke Distinguished Visiting Fellow at the same Faculty.

He was born in Lefkas (Greece) and graduated _summa cum laude_ from the University of Athens with a degree in Law. He holds a Doctorat d'Etat in Law from the University of Paris II Panthéon-Assas, a Doctorate in History from the University of Paris I Panthéon-Sorbonne and a degree of the École Pratique des Hautes Etudes-IVème Section, Histoire et Philologie. He speaks English, French, German, Italian and Greek and is the author of many publications in the area of public law.

He was awarded with the distinctions of Chevalier de la Légion d'Honneur of the French Republic, Cavaliere dell'Ordine di Merito of the Italian Republic, the La Croix d'Officier de l'Ordre du Mérite de la Hongrie and was honored as Grande-Oficial da Ordem do Infante D. Henrique from the Portuguese Republic.
