

Pan-Suk Kim – Professor Emeritus at Yonsei University in South Korea, International Fellow of the National Academy of Public Administration in Washington DC, Commission Member of the International Civil Service Commission of the United Nations

Dr. Pan Suk Kim is a Professor Emeritus of Public Administration in the College of the Humanities and Social Sciences at Yonsei University in South Korea. He is the Chairperson of the Public Officials Occupational Accident Compensation and Pension Committee in the Korean Government and the International Director of the American Society for Public Administration (ASPA). He is an elected lifetime international fellow of the National Academy of Public Administration (NAPA) in Washington DC. He is a commission member of the International Civil Service Commission (ICSC) of the United Nations. He holds a BA degree from Chung-Ang University in Seoul, an MPA from Florida International University in Miami, and a Ph.D. degree from the American University in Washington DC, all in the field of public administration. He has published several books and numerous scholarly articles in major domestic and international journals and has been a member of the editorial board of many international journals. He has also received many Awards. He is an expert on public sector reform, public management, governance innovation, and international development.
