He has previously held a professorship at the European University Institute in Florence, where he served as head of department of law from 2003 to 2006, and he has taught more recently at New York University School of Law, Yale Law School, Cardozo Law School in New York, the University of Toronto, and the University of Trento. He is a member of a number of supervisory or program boards, including the International Association of Constitutional Law, ICON-S, and the Institute of Public Affairs (Poland). His most recent books are “Constitutional Public Reason” (Oxford 2023), “A Pandemic of Populists” (Cambridge, 2022), “Poland’s Constitutional Breakdown” (Oxford, 2019) and “Constitutionalism and the Enlargement of Europe” (Oxford, 2012).
