

Mikheil Sarjveladze – Member of the Parliament of Georgia and Chairman of the Human Rights and Civil Integration Committee

Mikheil Sarjveladze is a Member of the Parliament of Georgia. He graduated from the Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University, Jurisprudence. For almost twelve years he practised as a lawyer, working for Kordzadze and Svanidze Consulting, Svanidze and Partners and at the legal consulting union Mikheil Sarjveladze and Archil Mshvenieradze. From 2012 to 2013 he was the Chairman of the LEPL National Bureau of Enforcement. Then he served as a Deputy Minister of Justice of Georgia (2013-2018) and First Deputy Minister of Justice of Georgia (2018-2020). He is currently Member of the Parliament of Georgia and Chairman of the Human Rights and Civil Integration Committee. He had been also a member of the Committee on Legal Affairs.
