

Vishnu Varunyou – Vice-President of the Supreme Administrative Court of the Kingdom of Thailand

Dr. Vishnu Varunyou is a Thai jurist with a PhD in Public Law (Paris, 1987). He is currently the Vice-President of the Supreme Administrative Court of the Kingdom of Thailand. Dr. Varunyou was also an Associate Professor at Thammasat University in Bangkok where he still teaches as Invited Professor of Constitutional Law. During his professional career he has served as a Lecturer of public law at the Faculty of Law at the University of Thammasat. Moreover, as a Judge (2001-2002) and a Vice-President (2002-2008) at the Central Administrative Court, and as the President of the Budgetary and Financial Discipline Division in the Supreme Administrative Court. He has published various law articles and authored many books. He was decorated with the award of "Officier dans l'Ordre national du Mérite". Dr. Varunyou also holds many Diplomas and Certificates from the University of Paris 2-France, and from the Ecole Nationale d'Administration (ENA-France)
