Paul Gowder – Professor of Law at Northwestern University Pritzker School of Law, Chicago

Paul Gowder is a Professor of Law at Northwestern University Pritzker School of Law. From 2012 to 2020, he was a professor at the University of Iowa College of Law, with courtesy appointments in philosophy and political science. His research focuses on the nexus of normative political theory, constitutional law, social science, and law and technology. He holds a J.D. from Harvard Law School and a Ph.D. in Political Science from Stanford University. He has authored three books: The Rule of Law in the Real World (2016), The Rule of Law in the United States: An Unfinished Project of Black Liberation (2021), and The Networked Leviathan: For Democratic Platforms (2023). He is a member of the American Law Institute, a former member of the School of Social Science at the Institute for Advanced Study (2014-15), and has consulted with Facebook/Meta (2018-19) on election integrity and the design of the Oversight Board. He is a former civil rights and legal aid lawyer who has represented victims of police misconduct, predatory lending, employment discrimination, unlawful eviction, and domestic violence, among other matters.
